Start by slipping the crimp onto the cable and then insert the end of the cable into the hole in the threaded coupler. You need to have about an inch to an 1 1/4 inch passing through as shown above. Bend the cable over onto itself and push the crimp over the end of the cable. Make the loop snug, but too
