Also called bowel incontinence, fecal incontinence ranges from an occasional leakage of stool while passing gas to a complete loss of bowel control. Common causes of fecal incontinence include diarrhea, constipation, and muscle or nerve damage. The muscle or nerve damage may be associated with aging or with giving birth.

Conclusion: Change in constipation symptoms following treatment of fecal incontinence in women are small and are not significantly different between groups. Loperamide treatment for fecal incontinence does not worsen constipation symptoms among women with normal consistency stool. Women with clinically significant improvement in fecal incontinence symptoms report greater improvement in constipation symptoms.

Assessment of constipation and fecal incontinence We defined constipation according to the Rome III criteria for constipation [14]. Fecal incontinence (FI) is defined as the involuntary loss of solid or liquid feces or mucus. Fecal constipation (FC) is a decreased frequency of bowel actions (<1 every 3 days) that also may be associated with excessive straining during the passage of stool.

Anal leakage, or fecal incontinence, is the accidental passing of stool from the anus. Anal leakage can range from an occasional leak when passing gas to completely losing control of the bowel.

Anal leakage: Causes and treatments

For children older than age 4, the most common cause of fecal incontinence is constipation with a large amount of stool in the rectum. When this happens, a child may not be able to sense when a new stool is coming into the rectum. The child may not know that he or she needs to have a bowel movement.

Causes of bowel incontinence include: severe or long-lasting constipation or diarrhoea. irritable bowel syndrome (IBS) inflammatory bowel disease - such as Crohn's disease. severe piles (haemorrhoids) childbirth or surgery damaging the muscles or nerves you use to control your bowels.

Constipation and the bowel Severe constipation is the most common cause of faecal incontinence (or bowel leakage), especially in older people. This is because hard bowel motions are difficult to pass and may cause a partial blockage high up the bowel, resulting in watery bowel motions flowing around the constipated stool without warning.

Functional bowel disorders, including constipation, fecal impaction, and fecal incontinence, are common gastrointestinal diseases in the elderly and a major source of morbidity. Often the etiology is multifactorial. Evaluation should investigate presenting symptoms and important historical clues.

It is important to distinguish this disorder from constipation-associated fecal incontinence, which is far more common (in 80 percent of children, fecal incontinence is associated with constipation). Children with fecal incontinence should have a careful evaluation for underlying constipation, including a digital rectal examination, because constipation is not always recognized by the child or caregiver.

Fecal incontinence (also called bowel or stool or anal incontinence) is the involuntary loss of stool from the bowel. It can range in severity from occasional leakage when you pass gas to the complete loss of bowel control. Who can get it? Occasional soiling is reported by up to 20% of people, whereas complete loss of control is much less common.
