Pragmatics, like discourse analysis, goes beyond structural study of the phrase and focuses on higher units -speech acts and conversation turns: What is more, it focuses on its object of study through consideration of the context and its construction, through recognition of speaker intention, and through the establishment of implicit elements which the hearer has to access.

Pragmatics and discourse analysis

Pragmatics is also specifically concerned with the theoretical perspective of the cooperative principle: that discoursing is a function of participants having a shared interest or purpose, which provides a unifying shape to the discourse, which prevents it from just being a series of random and disconnected topics.

Discourse and Pragmatics
