Fish ' s Reader Response Criticism is composed of two interdependent ideas: first, that the meaning of texts is shaped by the reading experience itself, and second, that these meanings cannot be judged to be correct or incorrect, but merely belonging to one " interpretive community " or another.

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At its most basic level, reader-response criticism considers readers' reactions to literature as vital to interpreting the meaning of the text. However, reader-response criticism can take a number of different approaches. A critic deploying reader-response theory can use a psychoanalytic lens, a feminist lens, or even a structuralist lens.

However, reader-response criticism, as modern literary philosophy emerged between the 1960s and 80s, particularly in German and the US. The clearly dominated the work of Roland Barthes, Norman Holland, Wolfgang Iser, Stanley Fish, and many others. Fish calls this kind of reader response affective stylistics A form of experiential reader-response criticism in which readers first surrender themselves to the text, then concentrate on their reading responses while reading, and ultimately describe the reading experience by structuring their reading responses., reminding us of the " affect " that literature has on us and of the New Critical affective fallacy that rejected any emotional response a reader might have to a literary work.

New Criticism, the culmination of liberal humanist ideals, had stressed that only that which is within a text is part of the meaning of the text; that the text is " autotelic " entity (complete within itself).

Fish's collective stance on reader-response criticism is that readers compose texts based upon the interpretive strategies transmitted to them (Harker 32). The next component of reader-response criticism is the Subjective Reader-Response Theory, guided by David Bleich's view that reader responses are not based on the text, but rather they are the text. ...
