On the other hand, serif fonts have clearly defined italics with a sharper contract and are more readable for longer passages. For this reasons, they are recommended for use in the writing of academic papers. Examples of serif fonts are Times New Roman, Courier, Palatino and New Century Schoolbook. The best font for a college essay is Times New Roman.

For academic papers, an "easily readable typeface" means a serif font, and a "standard" type size is between 10 and 12 point. Use A Serif Font Serifs are the tiny strokes at the end of a letter's main strokes. Serif fonts have these extra strokes; sans serif fonts do not.

FONT. Rule: College papers should be in a standard academic font: either Times New Roman or Cambria, in 12pt size. (If you submit a paper in another font, I will change it on the file I download.)
